

## Instructions for Customs Declaration



This customs form must be completed for each person traveling OR for each family unit. If you have problems with the URL provided above, you can use this QR code to access the Customs website.



DO NOT SKIP THIS STEP. If you do, you will have to complete this step in the Honduras airport, and it will delay your exit.

1. If this site defaults to Spanish, change the language to English in the black header box entitled, “Registro de Declaración Jurada Regional del Viajero.”

4. Take a picture of the QR code and print-out the 2-page Customs Declaration.
